Jerry Feinstone of Boscos named "Tennessee Restaurateur of the Year"

Jerry Feinstone, President and Founder of Boscos, has been named the Tennessee Restaurant Association's 2007 E. Carlton Scruggs Tennessee Restaurateur of the Year.

The award is given annually to an individual who not only exhibits the ability to operate a financially sound business while exhibiting exceptional ethical standards, but is also involved in their local community and gives time and support to all involved in the Tennessee restaurant business.

Feinstone, an active Tennessee Restaurant Association board member, was instrumental in rallying Association support for Tennessee's non smoking ordinances. His influence has helped craft regulations that now create a level playing field for all Tennessee restaurants and protect all Tennessee restaurant employees from the dangers of second hand smoke.

Boscos supports local charities including Ronald McDonald House, United Housing of Memphis, Nashville Cares, and the Regional Burn Center at the Med in Memphis. Local schools, charities, and the art community have all benefited from Feinstone's generosity.

The E. Carlton Scruggs award is named for the Knoxville business man who was instrumental in supporting the Tennessee restaurant community. The recipient of the award is selected by past winners.

Boscos was founded in 1992 as Tennessee's first restaurant brewery in Germantown, TN. Boscos has since opened locations in Nashville and Memphis, Tennessee and Little Rock, Arkansas. Boscos will open a new location in early 2008 in the Cool Springs area of Williamson County, Tennessee.
